## **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

- 1. Five of ten pastors indicated their churches "do" Ingathering. The responses of how they do it is mixed. Some churches go door to door, approaches businesses, or simply raise money through personal donations. The most commonly referred to suggestion for improving Ingathering is getting rid of it. "Eliminate it." "End it." etc. One church is doing Campaign for Community. Another pastor has heard of the ADRA approach and thinks that is the way to go. Two specific suggestions: Regular awareness is needed throughout the whole year on Ingathering and perhaps the NAD could help us in this area; Why not have stationary spots throughout town to collect money, much like the Salvation Army does at Christmas time?
- 2. Net '96 was mentioned by five of ten pastors as part of their evangelistic success in the last year or so. A couple pastors did mention Net '96, but it was to indicate how it "didn't work for" for them. The next most commonly referred to outreach/evangelism efforts were "tent crusades" and "Revelation Seminars". These were mentioned mostly by pastors in the South Atlantic Conference. The rest of the comments were across a variety of approaches: Servant evangelism awareness (car wash, painting homes, drive through Nativity scene), book distribution (Happiness Digest and a Russell Burrill book), a Bible Reading marathon, a Net '96 follow-up program, teaching greeters to be more sensitive in the foyer to nonAdventists coming to church, and a door to door survey which attempts to turn people's answers into an interest for Bible studies.
- 3. Four of ten pastors have seen Adventist Witness magazine. Two of them didn't look at it closely and had no comment. The other two were positive. One said, "Looked like there were some thought provoking articles." And two said they had/would pass it on to the Personal Ministries Leader or Bible Worker.
- 4. Pastors most frequently requested video resources (9) to help them in their ministry. The next two were print (8) and fact sheets (8), followed by on-line services (6), software (6), and live training seminars (6).
- +Comments on video: "Videos need to be 'live', not talking heads or people reading manuscripts"; "I especially want videos of church leaders who are successfully 'doing it"; "I didn't care for Hyveth Williams or the Pathfinder ACN events. Anything that goes on and on ad nauseum. I invited people from the community and was disappointed I showed this stuff live. I learned my lesson. I tape everything and preview first. I'd like to see more roll in's. We need to do this professionally. If we can't do it right, lets learn from the Gentiles. Why don't we have people like Dick Duerksen or Mike Poist

involved?"; "I need videos on practical topics like Stop Smoking and financial management, not doctrinal videos";

+Comments on software: "Its hard to compete with the good stuff that is already out there"; "I wish the NAD would update their software program for local church treasurer's to Windows, and also throw in something for a church database that would also automatically print out a church directory"; "I'd like a church membership program"; "I'm looking for something on management and scheduling, finances, and I'd also like the EGW CD-ROM."

+Comments on fact sheets: "It would be nice to download drama scripts for worship services"

+Comments on live training: "I think we are weak among professional speakers in Adventism in the areas of leadership and spirituality. I get live presenters outside of Adventism. Right now I'm pursuing Richard Foster on spirituality"; "I appreciated Greg Nelson's presentation on preaching. It was excellent"; "We had Dan Knapp come in and do Learning to Care for us. It was excellent because it was interactive, practical, and he went out with us so we could practice 'hands on' in real life situations"

+Comments on print material: "I'd like a new set of Bible studies created with a focus on science and archaeology. I think it would meet the needs of people in my community. I also think someone would do well to capture John Carter's approach to evangelism and put it into a series of Bible studies"

+Other miscellaneous comments: "I think we need more resources on domestic violence, I've recently went through training at Drew University and received excellent resources"; "I need more help in the area of keeping newly baptized members in the church"

5. Two of ten pastors say they have called PlusLine. Another pastor said he "posted" a note about it on the bulletin board at the church, but has not called it and is not aware of any leaders calling it. None of the ten pastors know of any church members who have called PlusLine. Six of ten pastors say they have called AdventSource and five of ten pastors say they believe some of their leaders have called. The areas mentioned were Pathfinders, Sabbath school, youth ministry, and regarding the Connections resource.

1. Does your church do "Ingathering" (or an alternative)? Do you have any suggestions for improving it?

We do a Nativity drive through. It reaches about 2,000 people. We have taken donations some years and given it to community services or some charity in the area. We did some caroling, but didn't collect.

End it. I think that Ingathering might serve a purpose in some regions. For instance, I have friends who pastor in small conferences, and those Ingathering funds make a large impact for them in their area.

2. What has worked well in your church in the last year in terms of outreach and evangelism?

Not the Net programs. In the metropolitan area it didn't seem to be that effective. Baptisms that resulted from them were on track to work with them anyway.

We do "Servant Evangelism": wash cars and give out free pop, paint homes, etc. has done well to bring about awareness. We also have "attraction" events. Marriage enrichment, divorce-care, concerts, special guest speakers. Our most effective thing is the Nativity drive-through is probably by far the most effective "awareness" event. But, it doesn't lead directly to baptisms.

Live training seminars - Yes, I haven't used a lot of Adventist folks, because I like
to bring people in for leadership, communication, marriage, spiritual growth stuff... there
are so many resources out there... I'm particularly interested in leadership and spirituality
and it seems like its an area where we as Adventists are not really strong. I've heard and
read some stuff from Adventists that "claim" to be experts but don't pan out.

Since this is the first time we are going to go at it, have no way to evaluate it yet.

We did Net '96, which worked well for us. We also did a distribution program of Russell Burrill's book on last days. We also inserted a list of felt needs programs the church offered. We have a door to door program with Happiness Digest. We have Russian and Hispanic that are doing individual work out of our church. I hesitate to call it door to door, its more person to person.

3. Have you ever received "Adventist Witness" magazine? If yes, what is your reaction? Positive/negative? Why?

Yes, received a sample copy. It looked like (scanned it) ... some very thought - provoking thing. Definitely feel like there is a need for it. I would suggest it as a resource for my personal ministry leaders and Bible workers.

4. What kinds of resources are you as a pastor looking for (or need most) in doing ministry in your church? (Yes/No)

Video seminars - Yes, very helpful. We use Mark Finley's stuff and anything along those lines.

Printed material - Yes. I would say, maybe a new set of Bible studies based on archaeology and science, especially for the neighborhoods around my church. Ancient discoveries. I've been intrigued by John Carter's presentations. If he, or someone familiar with his approach would write some studies, that would be great.

On-line computer service - Yes. I don't download much. But I do find it very helpful for picking up current information. I like to look over and pick and choose.

Computer software - I know that our church treasurer has a terrible time with the NAD treasury software. An update on that, Windows compatible, more user-friendly, and provided information helpful for the church, church membership information would be helpful... And something for more use of video tapes, software for tracking video tapes, etc. Let's say you have three or four sets out ... need some tracking software.

Fact sheets - Yes.

Live training seminars - We downlink quite a few. The one Greg Nelson did on preaching was excellent.

Video seminars - Yes. We've used Mark Finley's seminars ... there are some other seminars that we might use if they were available. The seminars we don't like ... are those that go on "ad nauseum" and not say anything. For instance, Hyveth Williams on Second Coming ... it went on ... the other was the Pathfinder one where two hours were spent of someone reading out of a manual. I would value video clips ... let's make the most of it. If we can't do it right, lets learn from the Gentiles. Some people know how to do this like Dick Duerksen and Mike Poist (independent guy used to work at the GC). He does videos almost full-time.

Printed material - Some of its good, some of its gets filed. All depends.

On-line computer service - Yes, I use the Adventist Forum. I think all pastors should be one. We ought to somehow make it possible for all of our denominational workers to be on this. I get on the Internet once in awhile. I realize many of our pastors don't have computers or modems.

Computer software - I wish they would come up with a software program that had a membership program, a desktop publishing program, a bulletin program, and I'm sure there is something out there available... it works for me. Some of this stuff designed for Adventist churches. Must be some programs out there, put out by Adventists, for Adventists.

Fact sheets - I like those. Our conference sends out the Monday Fax and Folkenberg's weekly thing.

Live training seminars - No. Unless I do them myself.

1. Does your church do "Ingathering" (or an alternative)? Do you have any suggestions for improving it?

No. I think the best approach is the one that seems to be in the works -- ADRA. I think this could be supported. Even if it does, I don't really see my members greatly renewed in their enjoyment of asking for money. I don't think there is a great future for that. One of the elders would like to revive it.

2. What has worked well in your church in the last year in terms of outreach and evangelism?

We've developed a very large and strong personal ministries department. They are developing a menu of things. It was mainly one person, who has developed a committee of 30. His view of Personal Ministries is broader than usual.

Prayer and fasting is one program he has led out in. About four a year. He also sees reading the Bible as a personal ministries thing. He's started a Bible Marathon ... certificates are given out. Its an annual event. The goal is to have everyone read the Bible through annually. They've developed a strong basis of workers for satellite work. He has a target group of 200 families that attended Net '96 that he wants to follow up. Forty teams are being developed. He wants them to visit three families each... I mean three times, a personal visit, a phone call, encouraging them to come to satellite '97.

3. Have you ever received "Adventist Witness" magazine? If yes, what is your reaction? Positive/negative? Why?

Yes. I think its very good. I passed it on to the Personal Ministries director. Not sure if he's subscribing or not.

4. What kinds of resources are you as a pastor looking for (or need most) in doing ministry in your church? (Yes/No)

Video seminars - Yes. We have a video department (and audio). We're trying to blend those together. We also have a tape duplicating ministry. We want to somehow merge all this into one unit. And then in addition, we need to get a stronger staff that will include acquisition of videos. We also want to have at least four different seminars available at any one time. Oregon had a curriculum type of guide, but in the local church to help all church officers see all the options for training. We are also working on our

second satellite projector, so we are getting close to where we can do that. As far as the resources, we have quite a supply of catalogs. We don't seem to be too limited with what's being produced from AdventSource, etc. If we tap into what's available as well as Priority One.

Printed material - No special needs. Most of what we need is created. The simplest form ... "The Quick Look" is done quite nicely. Those type of things are helpful. Simple and inexpensive for distributing.

On-line computer service - We have a computer and modem. We have a computer committee ... we are working toward a website. Not there.

Computer software - Not really. I have some incredible people in that area on a committee who are working on choosing a database ... they will serve us probably better than the "packaged programs" that are out there.
