My name is Curtis Rittenour and I'm calling on behalf of the Office of Information and Research for the North American Division of Seventh-day Adventists. I'm working on a project and have been asked to briefly interview pastors on a few items. Do you have 5-7 minutes to quickly go through them?

## **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

- 1. Four out of ten pastors say their churches "do" Ingathering. Sometimes it is simply putting it in the church budget (quite popular, especially where conferences "pressure" local pastors to do Ingathering). Caroling is popular for door-to-door Ingathering. And of course some approach businesses. The primary suggestions given relate to training members to go out, especially in reaching businesses. One pastor felt the "Executive" brochure given to businesses should have a little more quality to it since many businesses give substantial amounts of money. Another suggestion on the brochure was to put in a variety of types of disasters since some people may have a "heart" for certain types of disaster victims than others. Some suggest using buttons as incentives, getting brochures earlier, letting Ingathering die, provide a "local" flavor to brochures, allow money to stay locally, etc. One pastor complained, "I wish the money would go toward what we tell the community it will go toward ... and NOT running conference offices."
- 2. What has worked well in terms of outreach/evangelism in the last year? It was a toss up between public crusades (three pastors, with two names specifically mentioned—Ron Halvorsen and Mark Fox) and Net '96 (three pastors). Other programs/approaches mentioned: Pathfinders/Adventurers, Community Services Center, Daycare Center, Cooking classes, Discovery Bible School lessons, and an emphasis on friendship evangelism and relationship building. This last pastor also used public crusades, but only after a strong emphasis on building friendships at work, through small groups, etc. Negative comments were offered as well: Net '96 didn't work everywhere, Net '96 works best with a LCD projector on a large screen (vs. an average size TV), the Discover Bible school lessons didn't bring the results we hoped for.
- 3. How many pastors have heard of or seen "Adventist Witness" magazine? Five out of ten. Some have heard of it, but not seen it. Some have seen copies floating around. One pastor received three copies and passed them on to his Personal Ministries Leader, Sabbath School Leader, and Adventist Youth Leader. One said, "Looks traditional to me." He obviously didn't like the look of it. Another liked it and plans to have his board vote to purchase a subscription.
- 4. What kinds of resources are pastors looking? Here is a quick run down of yes/no responses:

Other: Provide more materials in Spanish; finances inhibits me; we need a new Bible study series that is Christ centered (not prophecy-centered); I use video seminars in conjunction with my own teaching, not totally by themselves; get on-line services on the Internet, not just Compuserve; make the software affordable; I'd like fact sheets with tid-bits I could put in my church newsletter; I've appreciated Ron Halvorsen's lay pastoral training; my key area of need is Christian Witnessing training; I'd like to see a graphical/animated CD-ROM created for use during live public evangelism using a laptop, LCD video projector; the type of print material I need is in the area of training; I like to use lots of visual aids; I wish I had access to more ready-made transparencies for teaching purposes, some kind of exchange with other pastors; I wish I had PowerPoint, a laptop computer, and a laser printer; I'd like a 5 minute resource to use each Sabbath for a slice of our worship service, something directed to children, something that would pull them back, perhaps a video piece.

5. How many pastors have called PlusLine? 6 of 10. Leaders? 4 of 10. How many pastors have called AdventSource? 7 of 10. Leaders? 4 of 10. One pastor's wife wished there were more resources available in Spanish. Some pastors mention getting AdventSource catalogs. No positive or negative comments were given. One pastor said, "I usually call AdventSource. I guess this church is pastor-dependent. In my former church, I had someone do research on resources for me."

I'm now starting a campaign to buy the equipment to get ACN stuff. Plus, we have a couple of Pathfinder clubs and Adventurer's club. Plus we have a Community Services Center. Most of our work is for the homeless.

Church(es)/Position: 2 churches

1. Does your church do "Ingathering" (or an alternative)? Do you have any suggestions for improving it?

One of the two does. I know our ministerial secretary is hoping to help our conference shift directions. They are thinking being ADRA-directed. I think that probably having ... as I go to the businesses ... we don't do so much door-to-door as business contacts. I prefer the executive report myself vs. the little booklet. The booklet seems a bit limited in showing how professional the services are that we offer. The executive

folder is much more impressive, eye-catching. I wish it had a few more pages. I think that the brevity is probably done for cost purposes, but when you're talking businesses that often contribute \$100 or more dollars ...

Having more emphasis on what disasters and what areas have been helped in North America helps. But when you open the page to show a well-defined regional approach helps. The story ... diversity ... showing a spectrum of needs (earthquake, flood, etc.) is better. In certain areas they respond more that they can relate to. Earthquakes in our part of the country don't cut it as much as ... say flooding. Some brochures in the past show pictures with no identification of where it was ... such as a hurricane in Tampa, Florida.

2. What has worked well in your church in the last year in terms of outreach and evangelism?

I was, in the past twelve months, have been in two different districts. In my previous district, we held the Net '96 meetings. Satellite evangelism brought good response in a town of 35,000 people. Apparently it wasn't as effective in my current district. So, we are debating Net '98. So, the major outreach ... the biggest outreach was Amazing Facts, Mark Fox in 1994. It was a turning point for this church. So, they are open to live evangelism (vs. satellite). Seems the size of screen is a factor.

3. Have you ever received "Adventist Witness" magazine? If yes, what is your reaction? Positive/negative? Why?

Yes, I saw that. I've taken it to my board. We're going through a planning committee using the Rick Warren book, The Purpose-Driven Church, asking "What are we trying to accomplish?" But it came at a time when we had just changed the Sabbath school magazine ... too many changes at once.

4. What kinds of resources are you as a pastor looking for (or need most) in doing ministry in your church? (Yes/No)

Video seminars - Yes, one that we are attempting is the Love Takes Time one from the couple in Oregon (Corwins).

Printed material - Yes, things I can photocopy and/or hand out.... especially in prayer ministry, evangelism, and church growth

On-line computer service - I don't have a fast enough computer

Computer software - See above

Fact sheets - Yes, especially with graphics I could turn into transparencies Live training seminars - Yes

Other: Wish we had more slides and transparencies. Don't have the income to get PowerPoint and stuff like that, which would be nice. I copied out of Warren's book a visual that really helped. Roger Morton used his computer at campmeeting showing pie charts ... that was nice. If I had some pie charts to illustrate ... that would really be nice. Perhaps if there was a way for pastors to network and could send me a hard copy that I could make a transparency from ... charts, slides. Learning to Care, that Ben Maxon did, had some really neat models. On another point, if you have a Personal Ministries report for church, it would be nice to have visual material or suggestions for holding people, that

would be good. My mid-week service, I am going to include a video feature, along with the Bible study and prayer time, so we can draw from the First Wednesday satellite feature... you get the idea. Also in the area of Children's Ministries ... we're pretty limited in the features that we have for church ... something 5 minutes that can be used in church .... some excellent puppet thing on video ... in worship.

5. Have you ever called PlusLine (1-800-SDA-PLUS or 1-800-732-7587) or AdventSource? Do you know if your church leaders use Adventist PlusLine or AdventSource? If so, which ones generally use it?

Yes. I doubt it. They might.

Yes, probably more often than PlusLine. They send out printed catalogs of resources. They might have, but I think this congregation has been pastor-dependent.
